Sea horse (Hint: Use the **Advanced Search** to combine a phrase and proximity search.)
3. Propaganda for voting "Yes" for this issue in 1918. (11 letters)
Prohibition (Hint: Use the dropdown menus to limit your search to **Ohio** newspapers published in **1918**.)
4. Animal being hunted in Thailand, officially. (8 letters)
Elephant (Hint: Search for "Siam" instead of "Thailand.")
5. A husband left his wife because of too many kisses. How many is his limit? (3 letters)
Six (Hint: Use the dropdown menus to limit your search to **Ohio** newspapers.)
6. Animal in Holland Bitters logo. (4 letters)
Lion (Hint: Use the **Advanced Search** to search by **phrase**.)
7. The Cincinnati Reds played this team from Cleveland for a championship game. (7 letters)
Spiders (Hint: Use the **Advanced Search** to do a **proximity** search combining only some of the words in the clue.)
8. Directions to this state courtesy of the *Hocking Sentinel* on January 10, 1855. (10 letters)

9. Last name of the man who purchased the *Ohio Union* in 1855. (8 letters)
Bushnell (Hint: Use the **All Digitized Newspapers 1836-1922** tab to view a list of digitized newspapers from **Ohio**, and select the **More Info** link next to *Ohio Union*.)
