0:01	In this podcast, we're going to talk about how you can zoom in on an image.
0:05	You'll notice on the Image Viewing Screen that the image is bigger than it is in the thumbnail version but all the text is still very difficult to read. But you have several zoom options that will make that text much easier to read.
0:18	You can use the scroll wheel on the mouse to zoom in and out. You can use the plus or minus buttons to zoom in and out, and these buttons are located at the top left of the screen.
0:34	To reset the image to the original size, all you need to do is press the Home key, this little house button next to the minus button.
0:42	And if you want to focus on a particular section of a page, like if you want to zoom in on a search term, all you need to do is click on it and it will automatically center on the search term that you selected.
0:58	You can also move the image around. So, maybe you want to see where the top of this article started: you just click on the image using your left mouse key and move it, still holding that mouse key down.
1:12	Let's reset the image. You also have the option of viewing this as a full screen.



1:21	If you press the button that's next to the Home key in the top left corner that says Toggle Full Page , this will open a new screen and this will give you even more space to zoom in on the page. You can use the same zoom features as before: the scroll wheel, clicking on the page, the plus and minus keys.
1:43	You'll also see, at the top of this larger screen view, information about the newspaper. And you can browse pages and issues from this screen.
1:51	To get back to the regular Image Viewing Screen , simply click on the link in the top left corner that says back to normal screen mode.
1:58	And that is the basics of zooming.
